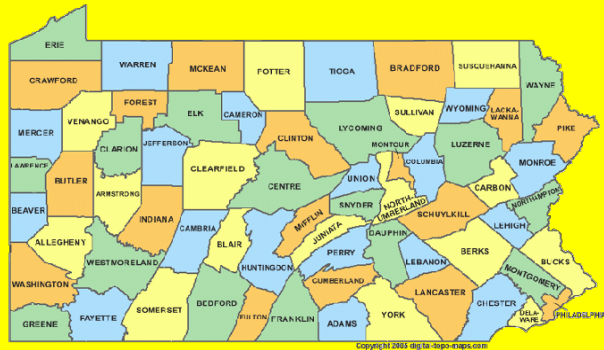
What PA county had the highest per capita personal income growth? Probably not who you think.

Top five counties for per capita personal income growth, 2016 to 2018:

- Greene County (7.5 percent)
- Fulton County (7.3 percent)
- Juniata County (7.1 percent)
- Potter County (7.1 percent)
- Susquehanna County (6.7 percent)

The IFO report also looks at population growth 2016-2018, personal income growth 2016-2018 and per capita personal income levels for 2018.

- Lebanon County had the highest population growth; Cameron County the lowest
- Juniata County had the highest personal income growth; Philadelphia County the lowest.
- Chester County had the highest per capita personal income level for 2018; Huntingdon County had the lowest
