PA State, Local Governments to Receive \$13.7 Billion from American Rescue Plan



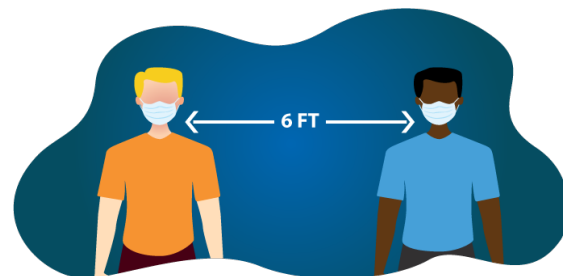
Funds can be used to:

- Address economic effects from COVID-19 including aid to households, small businesses, nonprofits, and industries such as tourism and hospitality
- Extend premium pay to essential workers or grants to their employers
- Provide government services impacted by COVID-19 revenue reduction
- Invest in water, sewer and broadband infrastructure
