

## BRIAN K. JENSEN, Ph.D.

Brian Jensen served as Senior Director, Policy and Advocacy, at the Allegheny Conference on Community Development from 2018-2022 and prior to that for ten years as Executive Director, Pennsylvania Economy League of Greater Pittsburgh. Dr. Jensen began his career in civic improvement and public policy research and development in 1987 at the Pennsylvania Economy League, Eastern Division and Western Division. His work has included regional economic development policy, sustainable energy policy, municipal financial health, municipal and state tax policy, regulatory and pension reform, and improvement of surface water quality and stormwater management. Dr. Jensen held leadership roles in successful efforts to consolidate earned income tax collection, eliminate Pennsylvania's corporate stock and franchise tax, reduce the PA Corporate net income tax rate, and to streamline municipal mergers and consolidations. He was instrumental in reengineering Allegheny County government in the late-1990s.

Dr. Jensen serves on the boards of the Allegheny Land Trust and Avonworth Historical Society, has served as a board member of the Local Government Academy, a trustee of the Governmental Research Association and on the Penn State Center Advisory Council. Dr. Jensen has a Ph.D. in History & Policy from Carnegie Mellon University and served as a Peace Corps volunteer in Liberia.
